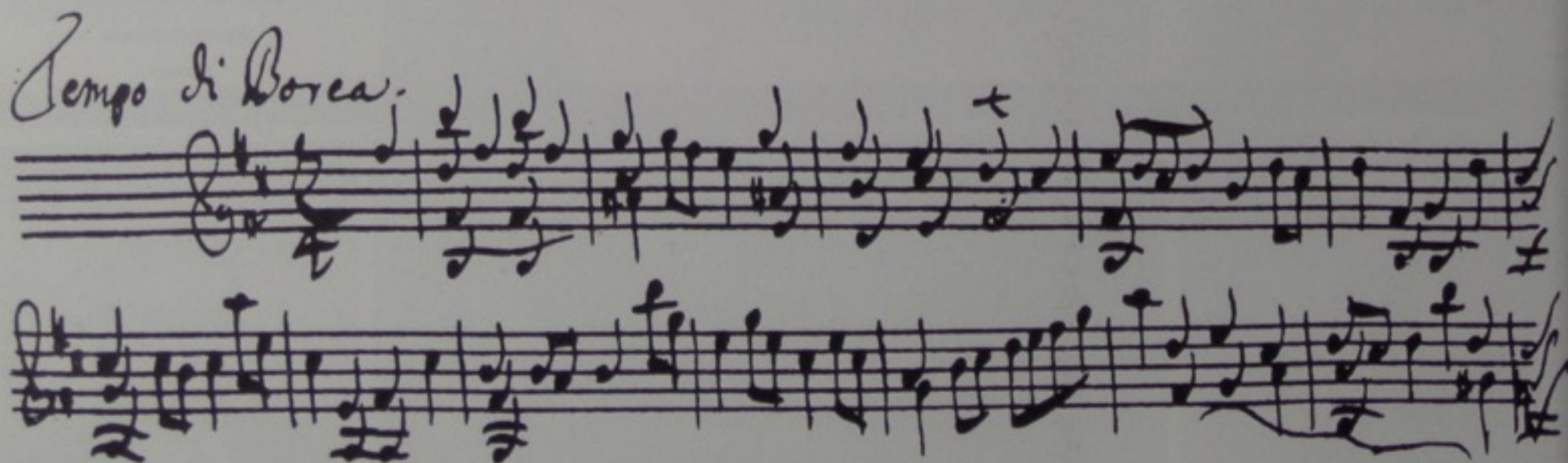

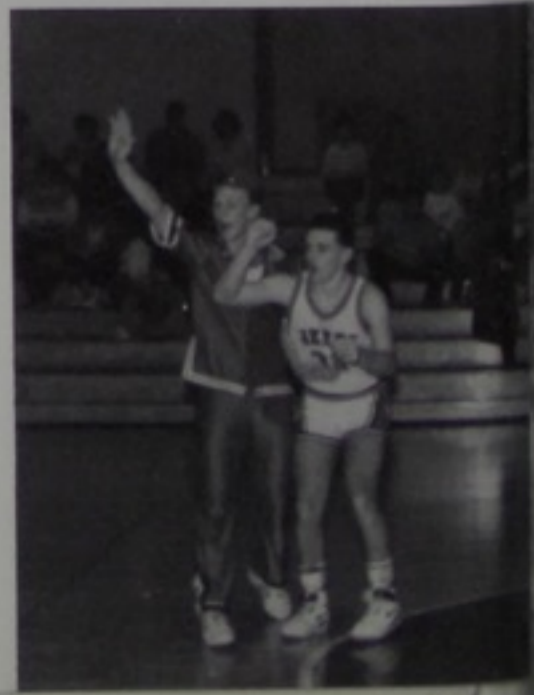

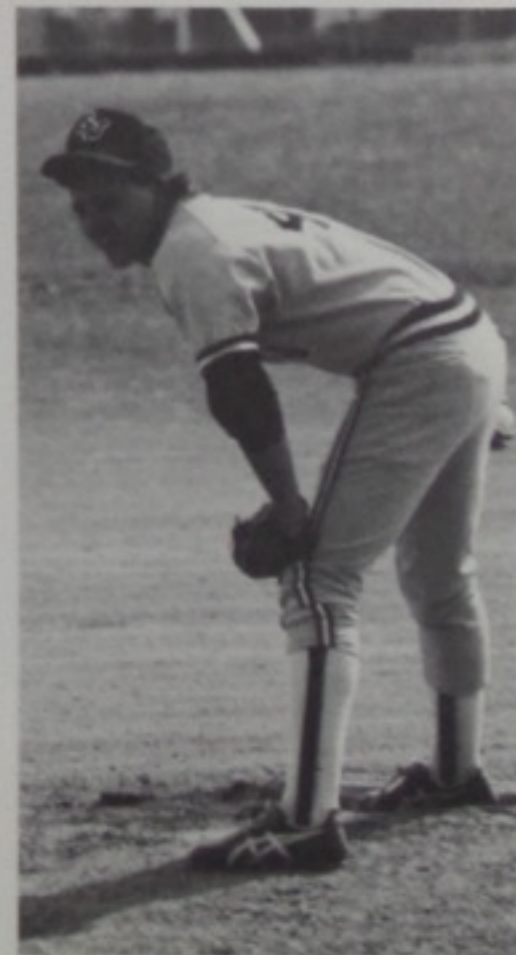

MAKING IT HAPPEN STEVE ROCKS IN '89

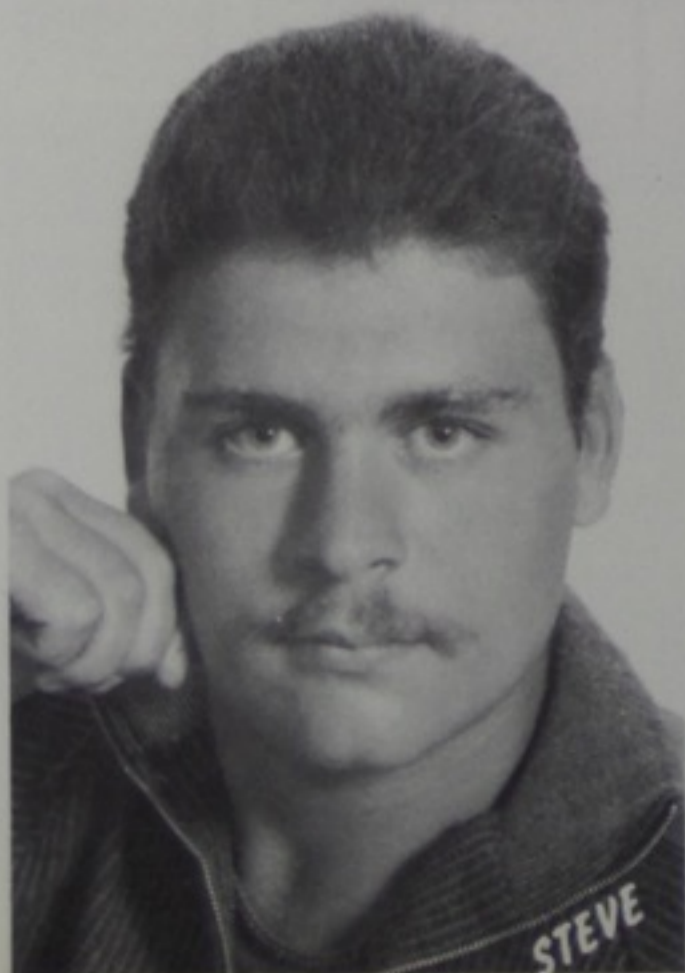
Of all the outstanding athletes South Webster has had this year, one certainly deserves some recognition. Steve Antonara is that athlete.
