
Superintendent of Schools, Edward R. McCowen

Senior Class History &

The Freshman class consisted of the following students: Jack Thompson, Arlen Windle, Carlos O'Bryant, Erma Moore, Juanita Miller, Ruth Tracy, Rosalee Pertuset, Viola Kirk and Louise Ward, with Miss Wikoff acting as our class adviser. The following officers were elected to represent the class of nine. Jack Thompson, President; Carlos O'Bryant, Vice President; Erma Moore, Treasurer and Arlen Windle, Secretary. Mr. Fouch was in charge of the Initiation Committee, which took place around Halloween.

Our Sophomore year began with nine students. The same officers were elected as in the ninth grade. Mr. Warren, our new principal, was in charge of the school carnival. Each class had a booth to decorate, and to operate. At the close of the year we had an outing at Roosevelt Lake.

We were really looking forward to our Junior year since it held promises of excitement. Our class now had decreased to four students. Some were married, others had secured work and one moved from the Rarden School District. Our Junior Class Play was entitled, "Look Out Lizzie". The concluding activity of our junior year was a trip to Washington, D.C.

Erma Moore, Jack Thompson, Carlos O'Bryant and Arlen Windle made up the Senior Class in 1950-51. During our senior year a visit was made to the County Court House, at Portsmouth, Ohio. Here we visited the county jail, Common Pleas Court, and the Scioto County Law Library. The Class Play was called "Gone With The Girls", under the direction of Mrs. Clara Snyder. A trip to Washington, D.C. is now being planned for this year. The Baccalaureate Exercise is April 29, and the Commencement Exercises are May 3, 1951, Our Commencement Speaker is Leo Blackburn, present State Senator, President of Portsmouth Interstate Business College and a former graduate of Rarden High School in the class of 1929.
