A strong defensive effort was given to shut out the Greenup Co. Musketeers. The next game saw the TROJANS lose a heartbreaker to the "BURG" as they went down 7-6. The TROJANS, however, came back to defeat a good Russell team. Josh Matiz threw for 145 yards and two TDs. Alex Nagle was the leading receiver
with five receptions for 113 yards and one TD. The 5 th game saw PHS travel to Ashland, Ky. where the TROJANS gained their 4th victory. Parker led the offense with 162 yards and two TDs. The defense held its own with a 49 TD interception by Eric Johnson.
