Trojans Unveil Exciting Now Look In 28-0 Win P.H.S. At Greenup Co. Ky. September 7, 1974 "I don't think anybody that was there was disappointed," sald a happy Dave Lanz, as the mighty Trojans won a $28-0$ victory over Greenup County Friday night.
A brilliant 55-yard drive following the opening kickoff put the Trojans five yards from paydirt. Fullback Bill Marshall then bulldozed across the goal line in two plays. However, the score that put the game in the bag came in the third period as cornerback Roy Hehl stepped in to intercept an errant pass and ramble 37 yards to the goal line. After that touchdown there was little action until the fourth quarter when the Trojans took over the balt, and put together a 95 yard scoring drive, with Marshall going over from two yards out.

## Old Rivals Tie, 13-13

Ironton At P.H.S.
September 13, 1974
The Trojan spirit just couldn't be defeated by the Ironton Tigers on Friday the 13th. The game turned out to be very unlucky for the Trojans.
The battle was a tough struggle all through the game with P.H.S. playing catch up ball all the way. The Trojans finally tied the game up for good on Bill Mashall's second touchdown run. That set up the controversial play which cost the Trojans the game
In the last twenty seconds of the game. Juniors Greg Noel and Greg Chinn biocked a field goal attempt. while Senlor Roy Hehl scooped up the ball and ran for what seemed like the winning score
However. the officials ruled that the blocked klck could not be progressed past the point of recovery. but after the game had ended it was found out that it was legal and the touchdown should have counted. Even though the Trolans really won, the score went down in the record books as a 13-13 the.

## Undefeated Trojans Kill Courthouse Winning Streak

P.H.S. At Washington Courthouse September 20, 1974

The Trojan men battled fumbles, penaitles and Washington Courthouse Friday and came out as $12-10$ winners. The victory killed a 16 -game winning streak of the Blue Lions to keep the Trojans among the undefeated.
The Blue Lions managed to plck up their first score of the game on the fourth play following the opening kickotf putting Washington up by 8-0. Then the Trojans scored with $4: 21$ showing in the first half. A 10-play drive ended on a 31 yard touchdown peg from Norm Burrows to split end Steve Armstrong. The halftime score was 8-6.

Early in the final period the Trojans moved the ball 38 yards for a score, with the go-ahead touchdown coming on a 7 yard run from Bill Marshall.
The Trolans were faced with a stiff challenge when a P.H.S. fumble put the Blue Lions only 3 yards from the goal line. On the next play Courthouse coughed up the ball and the Trojans recovered. On fourth down, instead of punting out of the end zone, the Trojans gave away a meaningless safery.

## Trojans Handed First Loss Of The Season

September 27, 1974
The mighty Trojans were handed their first loss by the Boyd County Lions. The Lions stopped the Trojans dream of an undefeated season.
Key plays in the drive for the Trojan's first score were a 35 yard run by Bull Marshall, and an 11 yard pass from Norm Burrows to Steve Armstrong.
Going in to score for the Trojan's was Burrows. Then, Burrows and Marshall combined on a pass for two more points. Steve Armstrong and Steve Barney each caught four passes. Armstrong's receptions gaining 50 yards and Barney's good for 82 yards.

The final score, the first loss of the season for the Trojans, was Portsmouth-14 and Boyd County-25.
